If live flowers are used rather than slides, scapes should be available from each of the following daylily categories for demonstration and discussion:

CLINIC II

Ten to fifteen scapes for use in explaining Scale of Points. These should be known cultivars, plus a few seedlings. It is helpful if some of these are of the same cultivar with one rather good show specimen and another not so desirable in form, color, branching, grooming, etc.

- ☐ **12 registered cultivars** (9 different known cultivars and 3 of the same cultivar)
- ☐ **3 Different Seedlings**

CLINIC II MASTER PANEL

☐ **Registered cultivars:** This class consists of three scapes of the same registered cultivar. (The same three cultivars that will be used in Clinic II for judging.)

The overall height of the scapes shall not exceed 36".

☐ **Seedlings:** This class consists of three scapes of **different** seedling cultivars.

The scapes must be severed as close to the base as possible.

CLINIC III REFRESHER

Review of point scoring: Three registered cultivar scapes and three seedling scapes for demonstration. Seedlings must be severed as close to the base as possible.

AHS Achievement Medal: Three scapes of the **same** seedling for demonstration. Scapes must be severed as close to the base as possible.
