Exhibition Judges Clinic II Student Instructions and Materials

Instructions:

1. This material is only for those planning to take the exam for credit. It is NOT for auditors.
2. If you have questions about your eligibility, verify with your instructor that you meet the requirements to become a Junior Judge
3. Record your Registration number on the enclosed Application for Junior Exhibition Judge form and Point-Scoring Examination sheet.
4. Read, complete, and sign the Application for Junior Exhibition Judge.
5. Use your handbook, *AHS DAYLILY EXHIBITIONS*, especially Figures 9 and 10, plus your Practice Point-Scoring sheet during the written examination.
6. Upon completing the Point-Scoring Examination:
 - Review your exam carefully and leave NO comment fields blank (3 point deduction)
 - Re-verify your addition (2 point deduction)
 - Complete the clinic evaluation form
7. Turn in your exam and application/evaluation form to your instructor at the conclusion of the exam.
8. Retain the practice point-scoring sheet for future reference.
9. Retain the Senior Exhibition Judge Application, returning it once you have completed all Senior Judge Application requirements as noted in *AHS DAYLILY EXHIBITIONS*, page 14.
Note: You will become a Junior Exhibition Judge, eligible to judge, once you have received:
 - a graded point-scoring exam with a passing score of at least 70
 - a Certificate of Accreditation from the AHS Exhibition Judges Chairman

Due to many factors, notification of your exam status may take from one to four months. Please be patient.
